3. Welcome

Today we celebrate Mary Sumner, the founder of Mothers' Union. We celebrate her insight and perceptiveness in seeing what was needed and recognising the means by which the need could be met. Across the globe the 4 million members of Mothers' Union celebrate the life and faith of our founder. We pray for the mission of Mothers' Union as lived in so many countries. Mary Sumner's life showed clearly her belief in the vocation to prayer and the call to social action that flowed from it. These are the foundations on which MU has been built.

For the Eucharist

If the Eucharist is to be celebrated the Seasonal variations for a Saint are to be found on page 159 and pages 641-642 of APBA. The full text is given below.

Opening sentence: Those who have clean hands and pure hearts, who do not lift up their souls to what is false; they will receive blessing from the Lord, and vindication from the God of their salvation.

Psalm 24.4-5

Collect for a saint:

O God, by whose grace your servant Mary Sumner became a burning and shining light in your Church: grant that we also may be aflame with the spirit of love and discipleship, and walk before you as children of light; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**
